Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

How can I apply for an Edison Internship or Co-Op?

1. Go to the web site www.edisonjobs.com
2. Go to the “Careers” navigation at the top, use the drop-down menu and go to “College Relations.” This page will share all the details on how to register for the site and apply for a position.
3. To summarize the process:
 - Go to the web site www.edisonjobs.com
 - Click on “Start your search now”
 - Click on “Search Jobs at Southern California Edison”
 - Specify your search criteria by using any of the available options. If you would like to view all available vacancies scroll down the page.
 - Once you see a job you are interested in, click on that position. Then you click “Apply” to complete the process.

What are the requirements to apply for an Internship or Co-Op?

In order to be eligible for an Internship or Co-Op you:

- Must be attending an accredited college or university;
- Must be enrolled and/or accepted into an undergraduate, graduate JD or Post-doc academic program, be attending school at least part-time and be making satisfactory progress toward a degree;
- Must be returning to school in the fall semester/quarter following your summer internship;
- Must provide official transcript and verification of enrollment in an academic program;
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00/4.00; and
- Must be legally authorized to work directly as employees for any employer in the United States without visa sponsorship.

What are some of the key internship/co-op program details?

- Networking and social events with other SCE Interns/Co-Ops
- Executive Speakers Series
- Community Service/Volunteer Events
- Mid/End of the summer evaluations
- Paid, full and part-time summer and year-round positions
- Flexible start dates (May/June) and end dates (August/September) for summer positions

What is the next step after I submit my resume on edisonjobs.com?

Once you submit a resume it will be reviewed and screened. If your resume is competitive, it is reviewed by hiring managers for consideration.

How will I know if you have received my resume?

You will receive an automatic response via email in addition to an on-screen confirmation after your resume has been successfully submitted at www.edisonjobs.com

What are the application deadlines?

Intern & Co-Op positions are posted throughout the year with summer positions typically posted in January and year-round positions posted in August.

Who can apply for an Edison Internship or Co-Op?

Those pursuing an undergraduate, graduate or Post-doc degree may apply; all majors are welcome. All eligibility requirements must be met.

Can an international student apply for an Internship or Co-Op?

Yes, international students are welcome to apply as long as they are legally authorized to work directly as employees for any employer in the United States without visa sponsorship.

Is the Edison Internship or Co-Op paid?

Yes, Edison offers competitive wages based on your school standing and job experience.

What are the start and end dates of an Internship or Co-Op?

The start and end dates are flexible and will be determined by the Intern/Co-Op, University & Campus Relations, and the hiring manager. Most summer internships begin in June and end in August.

How flexible is the Internship or Co-Op with school and vacation?

The Internship/Co-Op is flexible. The Intern/Co-Op and the hiring manager will discuss summer school and vacation scheduling. Interns/Co-Ops are usually requested to work 40 hours per week. If the Intern continues into the academic year, it will be part-time in alignment with the student's class schedule. Co-Ops will continue to work 40 hours per week.

Does Edison provide housing or housing assistance if I am an out-of-state student?

Some positions do provide a housing stipend.

Am I guaranteed a job with Edison after I graduate?

While there is no guarantee of employment, the intent of the Intern/Co-Op program is to identify potential full-time, entry-level employees.

How competitive is the Intern/Co-Op program?

The program is extremely competitive. More than 2,500 students applied to over 300 internships offered in 2011. Ensure your resume showcases your experience, coursework, and cumulative GPA.
